What do you need to do?

Please provide us with an email address to which we can
send your eInvoice in the future.¹

Report email address quickly and easily:

1. Scan the QR code shown at right.²
2. Enter your customer number, company name and the address of the relevant retail outlet.
3. Enter and confirm the email address at which you wish to receive eInvoices.



Act now – don't wait!

What is an invoice?

- The electronic invoice (eInvoice) is set to be required by law beginning in 2027.
- An eInvoice is not a PDF file but rather a structured file in XML format that your accounting software can process automatically.

The benefits to you

- ✓ Quick processing Automatically
- ✓ importable
- ✓ Fewer errors thanks to automated processing
- ✓ More transparency

What will change at Lekkerland?

- Beginning in December 2026, we will no longer issue invoices in paper form – whether by post or accompanying the delivery.
- PDF invoices also fail to meet the new legal requirements.
- In the future, you will receive your invoices via email, in XML format.
- You will also receive a cover letter in PDF format that contains additional information about your invoice.

Here is how you will receive your invoice beginning in December 2026

Two attachments via email to the email address you have provided:



Invoice in XML format¹

- Legally valid
- This can be forwarded directly to your Accounting Department or tax advisor.



Cover letter (PDF)

- Supplemental information about your settlement document
- As usual, this is readable and contains additional information for you that you can use, for example, in a comparison against the delivery
